



ProOven Cleaning

Best practice guide

Refer to appliance manufacturers cleaning instructions before cleaning. Do NOT use on aluminium or non-alkali resistant or painted surfaces. Do NOT use on self clean panels.

1

Remove any shelves or grids, and wash in sink with Sunlight washing up liquid and hot water. Rinse and air dry.

2

50-70°C

Ventilate area. Preheat the oven to 50-70 °C. Switch off equipment before cleaning.

3

Wipe the base of the oven with damp paper towel to remove any loose debris.

4

20-30 Min.

Using Gloves and Goggles, spray Cif Oven & Grill Cleaner evenly into the warm oven. Do NOT spray into fans. Close door and leave to work for 20-30 minutes.

5

Wipe away food residue, grease and dirt with a damp cloth. Use a non-abrasive scouring sponge or scrub gently with a brush if necessary. Rinse twice with clean water and let air dry.

6

Reassemble clean shelves or grids.

7

Wipe down all external surfaces including glass door with a cloth and Cif Power Cleaner Degreaser. Rinse and allow to air dry.

8

10 Min.

Pre-heat oven for 10 minutes before use. Note: If the oven has not been cleaned regularly, several applications may be necessary to remove the toughest carbon deposits.
